# NPC Research – Reminders



- **Do not complete any NPC forms prenatally.**
  - All of the NPC Evaluation (bubble) forms should be completed after the birth of the baby (certain forms with pre-natal completion options went away in 2012). Family Intake and My Parenting Experience I forms are still occasionally submitted by sites prenatally. These forms should only be completed once the baby is born.
  - *Any prenatal forms NPC receives will be returned to the site.*

# NPC Research – Reminders



- **Family Update Forms:**

- Many are being submitted indicating the mother has given birth to a subsequent child (question #29), but the subsequent child ID is left blank.
- You must enter this new child into Family Manager to obtain an ID number before submitting the form to NPC.
  - ✦ NPC will email sites to obtain any missing IDs that are sent in. These IDs need to be provided back to NPC before the form can be processed.
  - ✦ If we do not hear back from programs, its very likely that these forms will not be included in year-end evaluation (ie – status report) thus mis-representing the great work you're doing!

# NPC Research – Reminders



- Please make sure that your team is using NPC **VERSION 11** forms.
  - Version 11 forms went into distribution July 2014. NPC still receives some Version 10 (and occasionally earlier) forms.
  - Any forms submitted that are not on a Version 11 form will be returned to the site to transfer onto a new form.

# PPPM Proposed & Drafted Changes

- Danielle has been working to integrate changes. Thus far through Standard 5:
  - Formatting – getting rid of the weird spaces/formatting!
  - Taking out duplicative policy and adding back in all 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> order standards.
  - Adding clarifying language and “intent” to some standards
  - Adding language around new QA calendar

# PPPM Proposed & Drafted Changes



- Significant proposed changes:
  - Adding level P1SS
  - Changes to level change requirements
  - Target Population (we reviewed this at an earlier webinar)
  - **Program Manager position: required minimum of .5FTE**
    - ✦ Currently required minimum of .1fte – **changing to .5fte minimum**
    - ✦ You can still combine this position with a supervisor position, but at minimum, .5fte of that position must be dedicated to only Program Manager.
    - ✦ Program Managers are not allowed to carry a caseload
    - ✦ Program Managers are responsible for all Plans/Analyses (can no longer pass this responsibility to a supervisor or ‘designee’)
