

Immediate steps to improve safety

- Mandatory unannounced licensing staff visits within three business days of:
 - any report received by the OCC for any injury requiring professional medical attention
 - any complaint received by the OCC
- Mandatory legal review of any invalid finding on a complaint

Safety strategies and initiatives

- Statutory and rule changes to strengthen enforcement
- Changes to complaint investigation practices
- Additional staffing and training
- Collaboration and coordination with Child Protective Services investigations
- Ensuring that parents have easy access to the information they need to make fully-informed child care choices.
- Stricter requirements for Central Background Registry enrollment
