HFA accreditation ensures local and statewide implementation of high-quality home visiting standards of practice for all HFO programs.

The goals of HFA include reducing child maltreatment, improving parent-child interactions, improving children's social-emotional well-being, and promoting children's school readiness. Highly trained Home Visitors accomplish these goals through 1:1 support to vulnerable families with new babies. Support continues until the child turns three years old, and in some instances through age five. Healthy Families Oregon is administered through the Early Learning Division (ELD) and the Department of Education.
