How much does it cost? Help on your grant application is FREE, from either/both the CCR&R or SBDC. Other trainings or services provided by these agencies may have an associated cost.

What can the CCR&R help with? CCR&R offerings vary by region, but their mission is to support families and childcare providers in meaningful and responsive ways. Examples of supports CCR&Rs offer include providing free or low cost child care related trainings, helping child care providers earn their CDA, helping child care providers through the licensing process, helping providers with quality standards and more.

What can the SBDC help with? Each of the 19 SBDC centers offer confidential, no-cost business advising from advisers experienced in writing a business plan, analyzing cash flow, marketing, hiring and intellectual property concerns. They can also help with QuickBooks training, cybersecurity, grant applications, franchising and more.

Are there other resources available? Yes, this is not an exhaustive list of community resources available to help small businesses. You can also consider reaching out to the Government Contract Assistance Program (GCAP). GCAP is part of a nationwide network that helps small businesses in obtaining government contracts.
