



## CPR And First Aid Companies That Have Extended Their Expiration Date

<b>American Red Cross</b>	For certificate card holders that expire between March 1 – June 30, 2020.	120 days	Card holders can download a free, online-only 120 day extension. The 120 Day Certification enables an existing enrollee to extend their current American Red Cross certification by 120 days from the original certification expiration date. This extension certificate is for student or base level certificates from instructor-led and blended learning courses ONLY. <b>Health and Safety Institute (HSI)/Medic</b>	Current card holders who expired on or after April 9, 2020 – August 31, 2020.	120 days	OCC will accept the recommendation put forward by HSI to extend the expiration date of their CPR/First Aid cards by 120 days or up to 60 days after the State of Emergency is over, whichever comes first.

OCC will honor the extension of the card holders for the companies shown above, up to 120 days or 60 days after the state of emergency is lifted, whichever comes first. Below is a scenario of how the 60 days may come first:

Expiration date on Current AHS CPR/FA Card	New Expiration date from AHS (120 days)	Hypothetical: SOE is lifted on May 1, 2020
April 1, 2020	~August 1, 2020	OCC compliance due date is <b>~7/1/2020</b> (60 days after the SOE is lifted)
