
6. Physical distancing of 6 feet among staff (teachers, aides)


7. Adjusting daily activities to limit the spread of COVID-19 (for example, limiting whole group activity such as circle time)


8. Staff using face-coverings


9. Minimizing contact during drop-off and pick-up, such as by having parents remain outside of the building


10. Requiring staff and children with COVID-19-like symptoms to stay home


11. Excluding children and staff who have had contact with people exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19


12. Daily health checks (temperature checks, symptom checks) for all children and adults entering the building
