



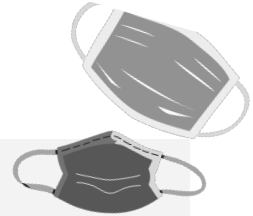
Face Covering Agreement Form

For Children Ages Two Years Old to Kindergarten

Kindergarten is defined as children who have turned five by September 1 of the current school year. This is the age a child is eligible to be enrolled in the public school system.¹

As the parent or guardian of _____, I am requesting that my child, while in your care, wears the face covering I have provided.

I understand the following:

- ✓ It is my responsibility to provide a face covering that is properly sized for my child.
- ✓ The cover will fit over both the nose and mouth and will be snug enough to stay secure without restricting my child’s breathing.
- ✓ I understand that the face coverings I provide must be washed at home with warm water and soap every day or after each use.
- ✓ If I provide a single-use face covering it will be disposed of as soon as it is damp and must be replaced daily.
- ✓ If my child has a difficult time wearing the mask, is constantly touching, removing or adjusting it, my child will not be forced to continue to wear it.
- ✓ I understand that my child will not wear a face covering while eating, drinking, resting or sleeping.
