

SCREENING QUESTIONS FOR COVID-19



Do you or your child have the following symptoms: ¹

- Unusual cough
- Loss of taste or smell
- Shortness of breath
- Fever

Have you or your child been exposed to a positive case of COVID-19 in the past 14 days?^{1, 2}

Have you or your child been exposed to a presumptive case of COVID-19 in the past 14 days?²

¹ Staff members who are fully vaccinated and two weeks have passed since their final dose are not required to screen themselves daily for health check questions 1 and 2, but must continue to monitor for COVID-19 symptoms as described in question 3 and be excluded if experiencing the symptoms. Fully vaccinated staff are not required to enter quarantine if exposed to a confirmed or presumptive COVID-19 case, but must monitor for COVID-19 symptoms. If they become symptomatic after exposure, they must be excluded in accordance with exclusion guidelines outlined in Section 11, and are recommended to get a COVID-19 test.

² Exposure means close contact for longer than 15 minutes in a 24-hour period during the infectious period. The infectious period is two days before to 10 days after the person with COVID-19 symptoms first became symptomatic. If symptoms were not present, the infectious period is 2 days before the test was taken to 10 days after.
