

# COVID-19 CHILD CARE REOPENING GRANT CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

Funding is available to Oregon child care providers who closed during the pandemic and are interested in reopening.



Oregon Early Learning Division opened applications for the COVID-19 Child Care Reopening Grant on **August 30, 2021**. The deadline to submit an application is **November 30, 2021**.

Programs that opened after June 30, 2021 are also eligible for this grant. To be considered for a grant award, child care providers must complete a brief application and meet the following criteria:

## Licensed Child Care Programs

- Owned or operated a licensed child care during February 2020, and
- Stopped providing services between March 1, 2020 and June 30, 2021 (except for regularly scheduled closures), and
- Reopened or has plans to reopen after June 30, 2021, and
- Commits to be enrolled with Find Child Care Oregon and open for referrals.

## Family License-exempt Child Care Programs

- Listed and approved to receive child care subsidy with Oregon Department of Human Services (ODHS) during February 2020, and
- Stopped providing services between March 1, 2020 and June 30, 2021 (except for regularly scheduled closures), and
- Reopened or has plans to reopen after June 30, 2021, and
- Commits to be enrolled with Find Child Care Oregon and open for referrals.
