Dear Provider,

The Early Learning Division (ELD) updated some of the rules for Certified Family, Certified Center, and Registered Family Child Care centers. These rules, which were temporary during the COVID-19 pandemic, are now permanent under Oregon Administrative Rules.

At a glance, the changes include:

- Certified Center
  - Expands the use of Aide II for supervision of children until June 30, 2022
    - Up to one hour at a time
    - Maximum of two hours per day
  - Changes the qualifications for Aide II
  - Allows for use of hand sanitizer in specific circumstances and reorganizes the rule for clarity
  - Allows on-line courses for CPR and First Aid training through June 30, 2022
- Certified Family and Registered Family
  - Allows for use of hand sanitizer in specific circumstances and reorganizes the rule for clarity
  - Allows on-line courses for CPR and First Aid training through June 30, 2022
