



# CPR & FIRST AID

- Part of the CPR and First Aid training can be completed online. However, CPR training must have a hands-on skill assessment.
  - Practicing on the mannequins allows early educators to experience a real-life simulation that will enable them to practice and learn CPR techniques they cannot practice effectively in other ways.
- If you have completed an online CPR/First Aid training before 6/30/2022, your renewal date is the expiration on that card. You do not need to retake a course until your card expires.
- CPR and First Aid training must include pediatric CPR to count toward your licensing requirements.
- It is highly recommended that you begin scheduling your renewal CPR/First Aid certification months before the expiration date to ensure that you have a seat in a class before your card expires.
- You may qualify for reimbursement of your CPR/First Aid training. <https://wou.edu/tri/forms/> Current RS, RF, & CF providers, Aide I, and Assistant I positions may qualify for reimbursement.

Local Community Colleges	Search for your local community college on the internet. When you see a search bar, you can type in the word "CPR" to find results more quickly. Look for keywords or tabs that indicate: "Classes Schedules, Community Education, Health Education, etc."
