

# School-age Center First Aid Kit and Emergency Supply Kit Lists

## First Aid Supply List

**414-310-0550(10) A school-age center must maintain, at a minimum, the following first aid supplies: at the center, in any vehicle used to transport children in care, and for group activities away from the center:**

- Non-medicated adhesive bandages (assorted sizes);
- Adhesive tape;
- Sterile gauze pads (various sizes);
- A sling, or a large triangular bandage;
- Bottled water (for cleaning wounds or eyes);
- Liquid handwashing soap or hand sanitizer;
- Sealed antiseptic towelettes or solution to be used as a wound cleaning agent;
- Scissors;
- Tweezers;
- Disposable latex-free, powder-free gloves;
- Plastic bags (for disposing of blood and other body fluids);
- Mercury-free and glass-free thermometer;
- Cold pack;
- Chlorine bleach or other disinfectant for sanitizing after a blood spill, cleaning spills of blood and other bodily fluids;
- Flexible rolled gauze; and
- A chart or handbook of first aid instructions.
- ❖ A school-age center must ensure that the first aid supplies are readily available to staff and **kept inaccessible to children**.
- ❖ A school-age center must maintain the first aid supplies in a clean and sanitary manner and replace them as needed, including expired items.

## Emergency Supply Kit

**310-0180(10) A school-age center must have access to an emergency supply kit in a location known to all staff. Supplies must include at a minimum:**

- First aid supplies, hand sanitizer, wet wipes, and tissue;
- A whistle or air horn;
- A working flashlight and spare batteries; and
- A battery or solar powered radio.
- ❖ If a center is in a school building, the emergency kit can be shared with the school, as long as staff know where it is and can access it at any time.
